

How our tutor training works

Kidsafe provides the two day training course **free of charge**. Schools are then required to pay an annual registration fee to use the Kidsafe programmes. Tutors attend annual refresher training to keep their skills current and their school's Kidsafe Registration valid. Tutors have access to an online forum with regular updates.
